



## Flickr



In the right hand corner, select the camera. From the drop down menu, select “Settings”.



Under Personal Information, select “Edit Who Can See What”.

## Your account / Your profile privacy

Your profile page is accessible by visitors to Flickr. You may want to prevent members of the general public (or Flickr) from seeing certain information about you.

On the other hand, a fleshed-out profile is more useful to everyone. Don't worry too much.

### Who can see what?

You can control who is able to see different parts of your profile. For each of the items below, select who should be able to view it. (We've tried to set intelligent defaults for you!)

### Your photos

### Your profile

- Hide me from site-wide searches on flickr.com and on 3rd party sites that use the API?

Selecting this option means that you (your Flickr screen name, real name, or email address) won't be found by people searches or the “find your friends” feature. It also hides your buddy icon from appearing on any contact lists.



Under this menu, the following is recommended:

**Your Photos:** Select the check box for both “Hide your photos from site-wide searches” and “Hide your photos from searches on 3<sup>rd</sup> party sites”

**Your Profile:** Select the check box for “Hide me from site-wide searches”.



Return to the “Your account” menu and select the “Privacy & Permissions tab. The following is recommended:

- Who can download your images?:** Family and Friends or Only you
- Allow others to share your stuff:** No
- Allow your stuff to be added to a gallery:** No
- Hide your EXIF data:** Yes
- Show which application you used for uploading:** No
- Hide your stuff from public searches:** Yes
- Who can see your profile:** Friends and family or Nobody
- Make you photos eligible for invitation by Getty Images:** No thanks
- Show autotags:** No

Under “Defaults” for new uploads, the following is suggested:


**Who will be able to see, comment on, add notes, or add people:** Friends and Family or Only You

**Who will be able to see your stuff on a map:** Only You

**Import EXIF location data:** No

**What Safety Level and Content Type will your photostream have and Search Settings:**

These are personal preferences and should be determined by you for the best fit for your content.



Select the “Sharing and Extending” Tab at the top of the account menu. Here, you can see which third-party accounts are connected to your profile. It is recommended that you do **not** link any other account to your Flickr page.
