## **Command Sgt. Maj. Gregory M. Chambers**

Command Sgt. Maj. Gregory M. Chambers is a native of Yakima, Wash. He entered the United States Army on Nov. 2, 1987 and attended Basic Training at Fort Dix, N.J., and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Eustis, Va.

Chambers past assignments include D and B Companies, 3-123rd Aviation Regiment, Fort Ord, Calif.; B Co., 2-2 Aviation Regiment, Korea; and 1st Staff and Faculty, 765th Transportation Battalion, Fort Eustis, Va.

His first assignment to the 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne) was from April 1996 through June 2005. His duties included Green Platoon noncommissioned officer in charge (Special Operations Aviation Training Company), Direct Action Penetrator platoon sergeant (D Co., 1-160<sup>th</sup> SOAR (A)), first sergeant (A Co., 2-160th and SOATC). His last assignment was as F Co., 1-160<sup>th</sup> SOAR (A) first sergeant. Chambers returned to the 160th SOAR(A) in June 2006 and served in the following positions: 4-160th command sergeant major at Fort Lewis, Wash. from 2006 to 2009, Task Force 1-160th command sergeant major at Fort Campbell, Ky. from 2009 to 2011, and the regimental command sergeant major from 2011 to July 2014.



Chambers is a graduate of the Sergeants Major Academy and he has a Bachelor of Science degree from Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Professional Aeronautics. Chambers' awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Master Aircraft Crew Member Badge, Parachutist Badge and Air Assault Badge.
