


YouTube

After logging into your YouTube account, click the Initial Letter icon in the top right corner, then click the widget.



Under “Overview”, you can be redirected to your Google account page (see Google handout) by clicking “View or change your account settings”. Under “Managers” you can add or remove various accounts and who can manage the profile.



Next, click on “Connected accounts.” Under this tab, you can view which social media accounts you have connected to your YouTube account and what information is shared between your connected accounts and your YouTube account. It is recommended that you do not associate your other social media accounts to your YouTube accounts.



Next, click the “Privacy” tab. This tab allows you to control what information is shared publicly on your YouTube account. It is recommended that you “Keep all liked videos and saved playlists private” AND “Keep all my subscriptions private.” Under “Activity Feed”, it is recommended that you do not allow the posts to your public activity feed”. In addition, if you click on the “Google Ads Settings” link, you will be taken to the Google Ads privacy settings page, which will allow you to turn off targeting ads.


