



## Kindle Paperwhite (2015)



On the home screen of your Kindle, select the three lines on the top right side of the screen. Then select “Settings” in the drop down menu.




In “Settings”, select “Registration and Household”.

## Kindle Paperwhite (2015)




This will allow you to create accounts for your children and other members of your household on the Kindle.




Return to "Settings" and select "Device Options".

## Kindle Paperwhite (2015)




It is recommended that you set a password to protect your device. To set a password select “Device Passcode.”




Enter and confirm your passcode.

## Kindle Paperwhite (2015)




Return to device options. If you would like to set parental controls, select “Parental Controls”.




If you have set up an account for your child/children, select Kindle FreeTime.

## Kindle Paperwhite (2015)




Kindle FreeTime allows you to fill up your child's/children's accounts with approved book and set reading goals for your child/children. This will also allow you to track your child/children's progress.
