



COMMAND SGT. MAJ. MICHAEL R. WEIMER USASOC Command Sergeant Major

Command Sgt. Maj. Michael R. Weimer is an Army Special Forces operator who assumed responsibility as the command senior enlisted leader of U.S. Special Operations Command Central, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida in August 2020. This assignment followed his previous assignment as the Command Sergeant Major, Special Operations Joint Task Force Afghanistan.

Weimer enlisted in the United States Army in 1993. After he successfully completed Special Forces Assessment and Selection in 1994. He graduated the Special Forces Weapons Sergeant Course and earned his Green Beret in 1996.

His previous assignments include tours with 7th Special Forces Group, and 19 years serving within U.S. Army Special Operations Command (USASOC) including as USASOC's operations (G3) sergeant major.
