Major Curtis D. Feistner is a native of White Bear Lake, Minnesota.

He was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in Aviation upon graduation from the United States Military Academy in 1990, where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Systems Engineering.

His military education includes the Aviation Officer Basic Course, the Aviation Officer Advanced Course, and the Combined Arms Services Staff School.

Major Feistner's past assignments include Flight Platoon Leader, Executive Officer, and Flight Operations Office in B Company, 214th Aviation Regiment at NAS Barbers Point, Hawaii.

He joined the Night Stalkers in June 1995. He served as a Platoon Leader in A Company, the Headquarters and Headquarters Company Commander, interim Battalion S-3 (during Operation Southern Watch), and Assistant Battalion S-3 in 2nd Battalion, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne) at Fort Campbell, Ky.

Major Feistner assumed command of E/160 in August 2000, and later deployed his unit to multiple locations across the Pacific Command in support for Operation Enduring Freedom.
