Capt. Andrew Patrick Ross 3rd Special Forces Group (Airborne)

Capt. Andrew P. Ross, a Special Forces detachment commander, assigned to 3rd Special Forces Group (Airborne), died November 27, 2018, of wounds sustained when an improvised explosive device detonated while conducting combat operations in Ghazni Province, Afghanistan

Ross, 29, a native of Lexington, Virginia, was commissioned in May 21, 2011. He had more than seven years of service in the Army. This was his second overseas tour.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal (OLC), Purple Heart, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, NATO Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal, Special Forces Tab, Ranger Tab, Combat Action Badge, Combat Infantry Badge, and Military Free Fall Parachutist Badge.



Ross was posthumously awarded the Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, Meritorious Service Medal and the Combat Infantry Badge.
