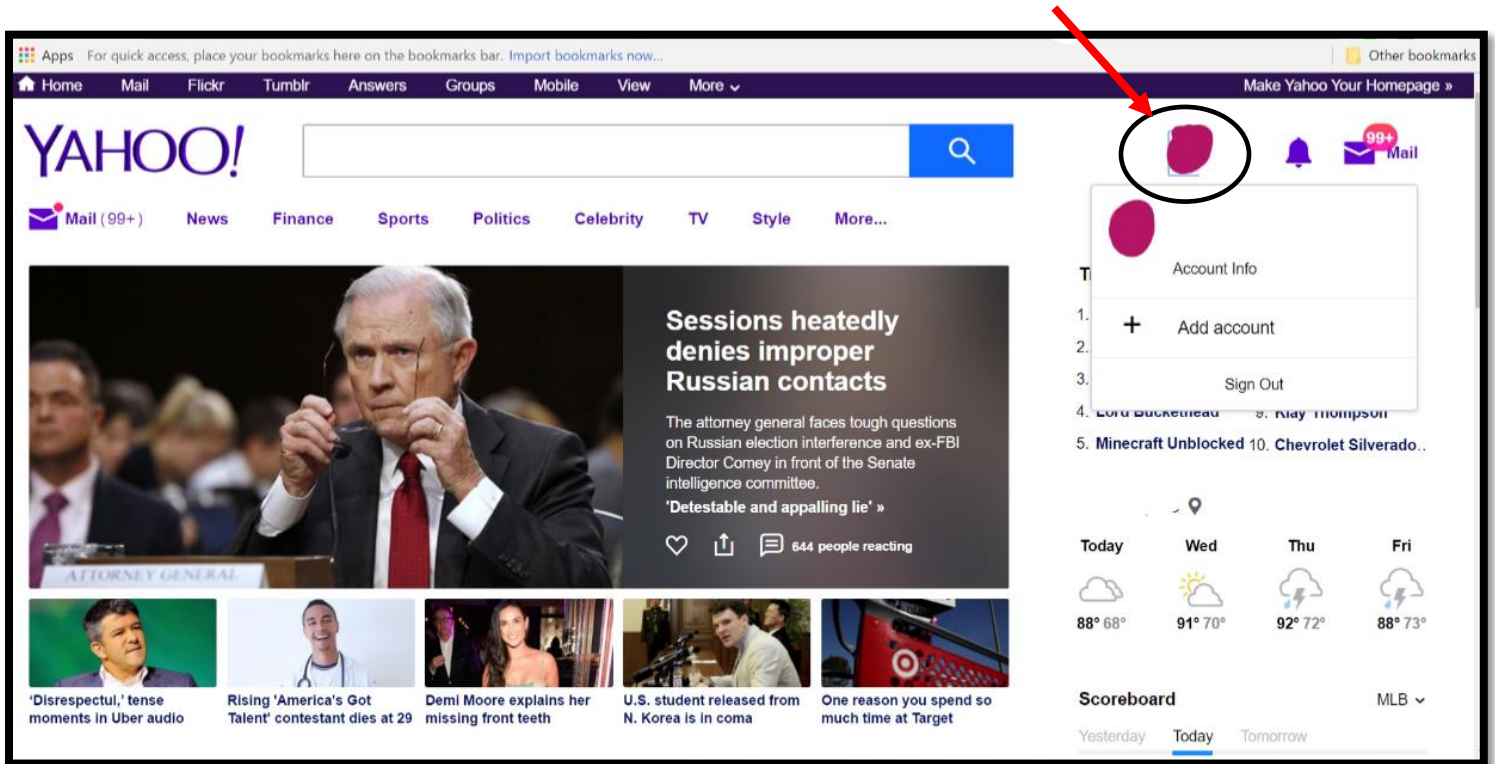
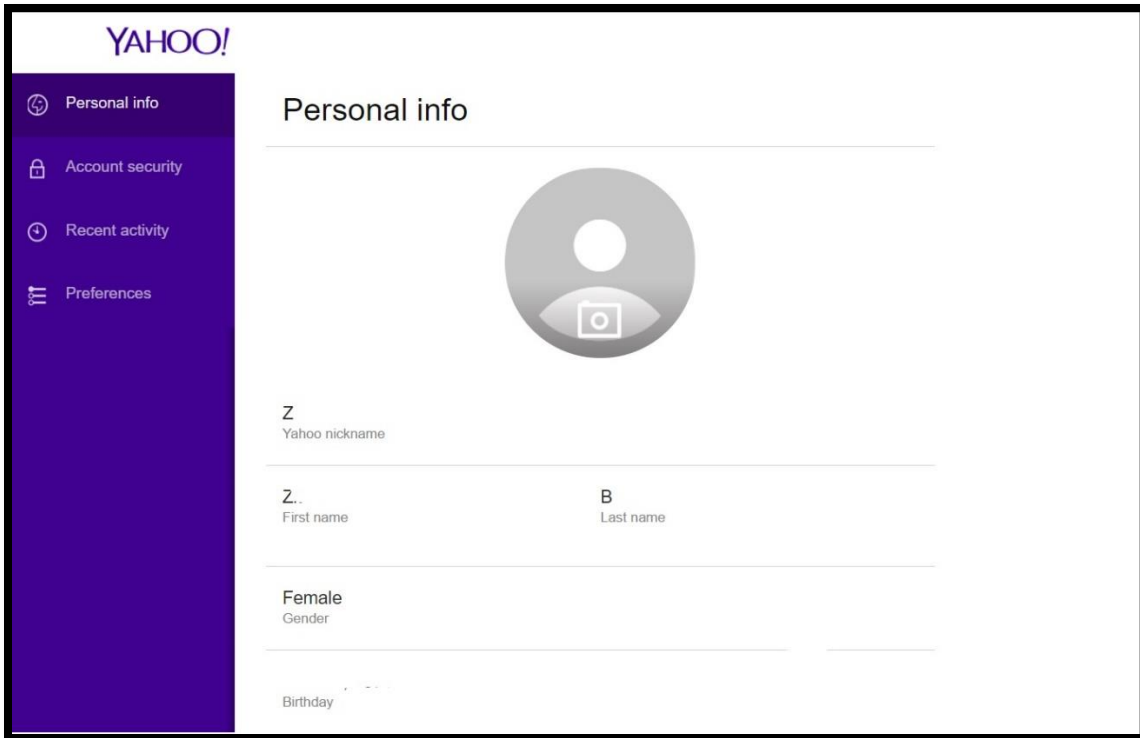


Yahoo

Log in to your Yahoo account and hover over the image that is associated with your account. Then click on **Account info**.



From **Account Info**, you will see the following menus; Personal Info, Account Security, Recent Activity, and Preferences.



From **Account Security**, you can change your account password and see any email accounts and phone numbers associated with your account. These are typically used when your account is compromised and you need to reset the password on the account.

You can also enable two-step verification. It is recommended not to enable two-step verification. Do not allow any apps that use a less secure sign-in method to link to your Yahoo account as this could leave your account vulnerable.

In **Recent Activity**, you will see all the sessions in which you are currently logged on to Yahoo, the most recent session will be at the top. If you do not recognize any of the sessions, make sure to sign out of it. If you

believe your account has been compromised, change your password and close all sessions and require re-login on all devices.
