# Introduction



We are pleased to welcome you to Fort Bragg, the home of the Airborne and Special Operations. SFAFWC is a 1-week course in which you will receive training on the most common foreign and non-standard weapons utilized within your Regionally Aligned Forces (RAF) requirement. You will receive both classroom instruction as well as practical experience with a variety of weapons at the range. Lastly, we will provide you with resources to continue your education and teach your foreign counterparts what you have learned here.

**Mission Statement:** Delta Company, SPT BN, 1st SWTG(A) executes the SFAFWC to train selected personnel in familiarization with foreign and non-standard light weapons and range operations in support of Geographical Combatant Command (GCC) Theater Security Cooperation requirements.

**Course Scope:** Train a Soldier who is competent with designated light foreign and non-standard weapons systems up to 12.7 mm. Soldier is capable of operating, maintaining, and employing designated weapons. Soldier who is familiar with constructing and operating company-size light weapons ranges with partner nation forces in a specific GCC Area of Responsibility (AOR).



# FAQ



## 1. What do I need to wear?

While attending SFAFWC, the duty uniform is OCPs, patrol cap, and authorized boots. The uniform for the range is the same with the addition of ACH, ear protection, clear eye protection and gloves and the option of combat top.

## 2. Where will I live/ Where do I report?

You will have to get a hotel room on or off post. ALL Students will link-up with SFAFWC Cadre at the top of the left (western most) entrance ramp of COL Aaron Bank Hall on the corner of Ardennes St. and Merrill Street **NLT1000 on Sunday** in OCPs for in processing and Basic Operations of Small Arms.

## 3. Are meals provided for me?

Government meals available but not provided. **Meal card holders must bring their meal cards.**

## 4. Is Friday a full training day?

Friday is a full training day and graduation NET 1800 hrs. Flights **should not be** booked Friday. **Flights should be on Saturday.**

## 5. Will I need a rental car?

Yes, only if you are staying off post. If you are staying at Moon or Hardy Hall you are within walking distance of the classroom.
