STAFF SGT JAIME J. MCFALL

Staff Sgt. Jaime McFall, a native of New London, Conn., graduated from New London High School in 1999. He joined the Army in 2000 as a human resources specialist. McFall chose to serve for the challenge and adventure, gain valuable life and job experiences and fund post-secondary education.

In 2000, McFall was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 7th Infantry Regiment at Fort Stewart, Ga. In 2004, he transferred to Fort Campbell, Ky., where he joined the 3rd Brigade, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault).



McFall, deployed to Iraq in 2003, 2004, and 2005 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. He served as a human resources specialist responsible for the administrative processing of all personnel actions for more than 800 Soldiers.

In 2008, McFall separated from service, but reenlisted in 2009, as a combat infantryman. In 2010, McFall transferred to 4th Brigade, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault). He deployed to Afghanistan as a light infantry weapons team leader. His work provided critical defense support to all U.S. and allied bases in the Southeastern region of Afghanistan. He worked jointly with Air Force Combat Air Support and the 75th Ranger Regiment.

McFall reported to 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne), in February 2013, and is currently the group assistant personnel actions center non-commissioned officer in charge for Headquarters Company.

A highly-decorated warrior, his awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, seven Army Commendation Medals, two Army Achievement Medals, four Army Good Conduct Medals, the National Defense Service Medal, two NATO medals, four Iraqi Campaign Stars, one Afghanistan Campaign Star, the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary and Service Medals, and three Overseas Service Ribbons. His badges include the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Parachutist Badge, the Pathfinder Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.
