SFC Jerry Germany was born in January, 1984. He graduated high school in 2002 in Mississippi (MS). During his final year of college, SFC Germany enlisted in the MS Army National Guard in February 2006 and completed basic training and advanced individual training (AIT) at Fort Leonard Wood, MO where he earned the military occupational specialty (MOS) of 12B, Combat Engineer. Once basic training was complete, he returned to MS to complete his final semester of college. After several years and one deployment to Iraq in support of Operation Enduring Freedom as a conventional soldier with 155<sup>th</sup> Brigade Combat Team, SFC Germany transferred to C-Co, 2/20<sup>th</sup> SFG (A) in Grenada MS where he completed the basic airborne course and Special Forces Qualification Course (SFQC).

SFC Germany has one deployment in support of Operation Enduring Freedom (Iraq), one deployment in support of Operation Inherent Resolve (Iraq), and one deployment in support of Operation Enduring Freedom-Horn of Africa (Central African Republic) between 2009 and 2016.

SFC Germany's military education includes: Special Forces Qualification Course, Special Forces Combat Divers Qualification Course, Military Freefall Course, Special Operations Target Interdiction Course, Special Forces Advanced Urban Combat Course, Special Forces Engineer Course, Operator Advanced Sensitive Site Exploitation Course, SERE Level C, Basic Airborne Course, Ground Reconnaissance Specialist (Phase I/II), Department of Homeland Security Personal Security Operations Training, Combat Engineer Course, Infantry Course, Advanced/Basic/Primary Non-Commissioned Officer Leadership Courses.

Presently, SFC Germany is assigned to C-co, 2/20<sup>th</sup> SFG(A), ODA 2234, Grenada MS and as an attachment to Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), U.S. Army Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg NC as a full time member of the USASOC Parachute Demonstration Team.
