SFC Michael Moore was born on May 11, 1984 in Metuchen NJ. SFC Moore graduated from Delaware Valley College with a baccalaureate degree in Agronomy and Environmental Science and a minor in Biology. He Joined the Army in 2008 as an 18X. He completed basic training and airborne school in 2009, and completed the Special Forces Qualification Course in December of 2010 as an 18E.

Sergeant Moore was assigned to 10th Special Forces Group in March of 2011, first as an attachment to the 2nd BN HHC Signal Detachment, then to Charlie Company in September. He has been attached to both ODA 0231 (JAN 12 - MAY 15) and ODA 0235 (JUN 15 – DEC 18) as a communications sergeant and reconnaissance operative. He has deployed on 5 Crisis Response Force Upcell rotations from 2013-2018 in Malawi, Germany, and Iraq.



Presently, SFC Moore is assigned to USASOC HHC and is a full-time member of the USASOC Parachute Demonstration Team.
